



Galileo appoints Francesco Dolzani as Managing Director for Italy

Zurich and Milan, 8 July 2026 - Galileo, the pan-European renewable energy developer and independent power producer (IPP), has appointed Francesco Dolzani as Managing Director for Italy.

Francesco joined Galileo in 2021 as Business Development Director. Working alongside a highly skilled and dedicated local team, he has built Galileo's Italian development organisation and led the origination and advancement of an increasingly mature, diversified pipeline exceeding 3 GW in the country, spanning solar, battery energy storage systems (BESS), onshore wind and offshore wind projects.

Under his leadership, Galileo has secured either planning consent or Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) clearance for more than 1.5 GW of projects in Italy. The company has also brought its first Italian solar plants into operation and expects construction to commence on more than 150 MW of fully consented projects by the first half of 2027.

These projects will form part of Galileo's growing IPP portfolio, with Italy being the first market where the company is expanding from development to an integrated IPP position.

Francesco brings more than a decade of experience across multiple facets of the energy sector. His career has combined work on large-scale energy infrastructure with hands-on experience in renewable project development and distributed energy, giving him a broad perspective across the full energy value chain.

Commenting on his appointment, Francesco Dolzani said: *"I am honoured to take on the role of Managing Director for Italy as we build on a mature multi-GW pipeline, advanced-stage projects and our first operational assets. Together with our local team and the wider Galileo organisation, the next priority is to convert this pipeline into operating capacity while continuing to originate high-quality opportunities across the market."*

As we deliver our diversified pipeline and continue our trajectory to an IPP, his pragmatic hands-on approach and great team-building spirit will be instrumental to succeed in our next growth chapter for this large and strategically important market."*
